

Tuesday Night Steel Matches

Come join us for an exciting midweek blast. Every Tuesday night there will be a Steel Match throughout the summer. Show up any time between 5:30 and 6:30 to register, and shoot until you're done. There is no squads, or order. Just jump in line, shoot the course of fire, move onto the next one. Cost is \$10, and allows you to shoot as many times as you want.

Here's how it works: based loosely on USPSA rules, each competitor will be scored on time only. The assumption is that you will hit all steel targets, for each missed target there is a 5 second penalty. There is no limit on the number of rounds you shoot. None of the steel falls down, so once you are done and get your time, move along and let the next competitor begin. Courses of fire will be from 12 to 30 rounds with at least one magazine change. Bring at least three magazines if you have them. There will be some limited movement involved. We will always have three courses of fire, and if there is enough interest and set up help we will have four. You may shoot whatever you want as long as the handgun does not have Magnum power level. Most any 9 mm, 40, or 45 will work.

Safety: RCRC runs a cold range for pistol matches. This means that during the match your weapon will have nothing in the mag well, nothing in the chamber, and the hammer will be down. If you come to the range and your weapon is not in this condition, proceed to the rifle range and empty your gun. Un-bagging and holstering will be done in the safety area only; not in your vehicle! You may handle your weapon in the safety area, but not ammunition! You may load your weapon only when the Range Officer (RO), gives you the command " Make Ready" and it is your turn to shoot.

Set up begins at 4:30 and someone will be available at 5:00 to orient new shooters. Bad weather could cancel the match. Feel free to call for any questions. Erik Landvik at 970-846-6586
